
Highlighted as a more „traditional“ architectural display in this showcasing, this project focuses on handling a historic substance and how to translate its legacy into today.

The historic steel structure of the Schiller Opera near the Rindermarkthalle in Hamburg is being expanded with a rectangular new metaphoric display cabinet. The building is divided into a public area with a foyer, gastronomy, bar, and rooftop terrace, and a private area. The spacious foyer showcases the opera's steel framework like an exhibit, highlighted by a copper-colored finish and velvety green curtains. The rotunda is preserved as a theater hall, with the old and new elements blending harmoniously into a unified architectural whole.






Side View




Side section AA
